The Gates Recreation and Parks Department manages and operates five park/recreation areas in the Town consisting of approximately 137 acres. The following is a synopsis of the individual parks and elements within each park.



# Memorial Park



**160 Spencerport Road**  
Capacity: 125

Memorial Park is located on the north side of town and is 30.10 acres in size. The land is relatively flat and includes a shallow marshy pond and small stream. The park has one major access road running the length of the park. The paved maintenance road looping around the pond also serves as a walking trail. This park is a large open area bordered by hedgerows and mature trees. There is a variety of wildlife within the park including cottontail rabbits, gray squirrels, ground hogs, aquatic birds and turtles. Covered Band Shell/Pavilion with electric has 7 picnic tables.

# Lions Park



**100 Kentucky Avenue**  
Capacity: 95

Lions Park is located in the northern area of the town and is 14.58 acres. There is a 2.5 acre pond with a handicap accessible fishing platform. This park is lined on three sides with a mixture of hedgerows and mature trees. The paved walking path, on the southeast border of the park leads to Memorial Park. Lions Park is within walking distance of the Erie Canal Heritage Trail.

# Westgate Park



**1489 Howard Road**

Capacity: 125

Westgate Park is located on the southeast section of the town and is 16.42 acres. This park has about 5 acres of wooded area. There is a small hill area overlooking the playing fields. New trees have been planted around the shelter area. The park is bordered by the shopping plaza on the east, and a residential area on the north. This park is located directly off a main thoroughfare and is highly visible to passing motorists.

# First Responders Park

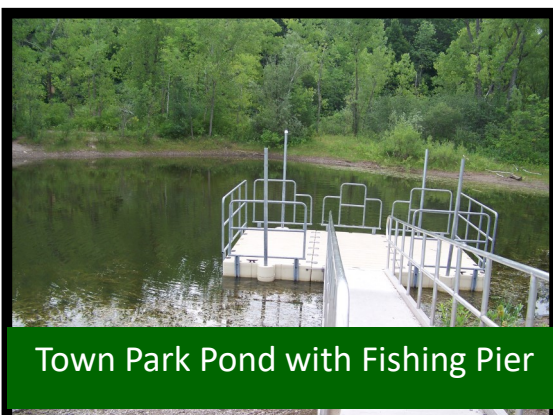


**4310 Lyell Road**

First Responders Park (formally Town Park) is 73.14 acres, a mixture of wet lands, wooded areas and open land containing a wide diversity of flora and fauna. Such protected plants as trillium and jack-in-the-pulpits can be found there. The park also has a man-made pond, and climax flora. Wildlife found in the park includes such animals as deer, rabbits, raccoons and a wide variety of birds. Much of the park has been left in a natural state. Park is open Dawn to Dusk April 1—November 1, weather permitting.

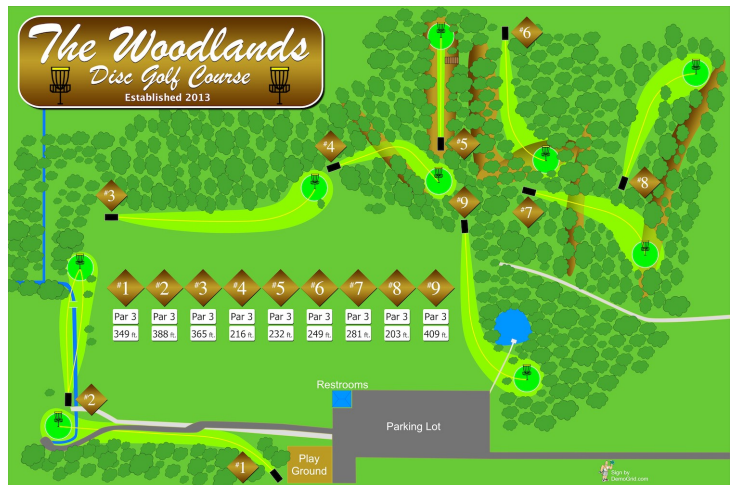
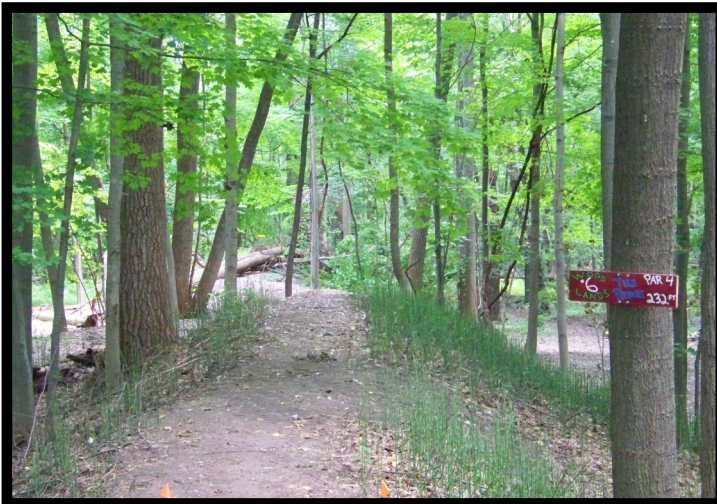
