WHAT IS AN ENVIRONMENTAL RISK AND RESILIENCE ASSESSMENT?

An Environmental Risk and Resilience Assessment is a way for the community to take stock of local risks--like flooding, heavy storms, or extreme heat--and see how they might affect people, homes, roads, businesses, and natural areas. It also looks at which groups of people or parts of town might be more at risk and how the community can respond and recover.

The goal is to understand where the community is most vulnerable and to plan ahead. By knowing our risks, we can make smarter decisions, protect what matters most, and build a stronger, more resilient community for everyone.
